General Rules

1. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2007.
2. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
3. All Junior riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
4. Cross entering between Pleasure classes and Hunter classes is permitted.
5. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant.
6. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
8. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months.
9. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
10. Four ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
11. Entry Fee will be \$10.00 per class.

Ring 2 - Pony Only Schooling until 8:30 a.m.

- 28-30. Long Stirrup Equitation Division
- 31-33. Crossrail Hunter Division

■ **Fun Division** Open to all.

- Class 42 - Pair Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
- Class 43 - Pair Walk-Trot-Canter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter.
- Class 44 - Team Walk-Trot - Open to three or more riders. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
- Class 45 - Pair Jumping - Open to two riders. To be shown over 6-8 fences 2' in height; will jump one fence abreast.
- Class 46 - Team Jumping - Open to three riders. To be shown over 6-8 fences 2' in height; will jump one fence abreast.

■ **Low Horse Hunter Division**

Open to horses only. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Crossrails 18”

■ **Pleasure Horse Division**

Open to horses only. To be judged on performance, manners, and soundness with emphasis on suitability. No martingales Fences 2’.

■ **Hopeful Hunter Division**

Open to horses only. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2’

■ **Schooling Hunter Division**

Open to horses only. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Fences - 2’6”

■ **Children/Adult Amateur Hunter Division**

Open to riders 17 years of age and under and Adult Amateur riders on horses. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2’6”

■ **Open Hunter Division**

Open to horses only. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Fences - 2’9” or 3’

■ **Lead Line Division**

Open to riders 7 years of age and under. Riders to be mounted on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged 50% on child’s hands and seat and 50% on mount’s quietness and suitability. No martingales. *Riders may only compete in the Lead Line and Mini Short Stirrup Divisions.*

■ **Mini Short Stirrup Division**

Open to riders 7 years of age and under. Riders to be mounted on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged 50% on child’s hands and seat and 50% on mount’s quietness and suitability. No martingales. *Riders may only compete in the Lead Line and Mini Short Stirrup Divisions.*

■ **Short Stirrup Equitation Division**

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount’s quietness and suitability. Crossrails 18”. *Riders may only compete in the Short Stirrup Equitation, Crossrail Hunter and Pleasure Divisions.*

■ **Long Stirrup Equitation Division**

Open to riders 11 years of age and over. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount’s quietness and suitability. Crossrails 18”. *Riders may only compete in the Long Stirrup Equitation, Crossrail Hunter and Pleasure Divisions.*

■ **Crossrail Hunter Division**

Open to riders competing in Ring 2 classes. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Crossrails - 18”

■ **Low Pony Hunter Division**

Open to riders 17 years of age and under on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2’

■ **Pony Pleasure Division**

Open to riders 17 years of age and under on ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged on performance, manners, and soundness with emphasis on suitability. No martingales. Fences 2’

■ **Hopeful Jumper Division**

Open to horses and ponies. Jumps 2’. Table 2.2.b
